



Construction of upgrades, improvements, and flood protection measures are being made at our Stage II Wastewater Treatment Plant in Montgomery Township. Approximately \$17,000,000 of the \$18,258,600 bid costs will be financed by the New Jersey Water Bank (NJWB). The NJWB is a State Revolving Fund program jointly administered by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) and the New Jersey Infrastructure Bank (NJIB) and uses a combination of funds provided by the United States Environmental Protection Agency, the DEP, and the NJIB to provide very low interest loans to borrowers for environmental infrastructure projects.

This project will provide water quality benefits to the Millstone River and its tributaries by keeping raw sewage out of the stream while having no negative impacts to the floodplain, soils, cultural resources, existing wetlands, riparian zone. The project will comply with relevant NJDEP regulations and permits issued for the project. This project will benefit residents and businesses in the Stage II sewer service area as well as any people, fish, wildlife, and cultural resources that will benefit by protecting the Millstone River.
