BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that these Personnel Policies and Procedures shall apply to all Township officials, appointees, employees, volunteers, and independent contractors, and in the event of a conflict between these rules and any Collective Bargaining Agreement, or Federal or State law, the terms and conditions of that Agreement or law shall prevail. In all other cases, these Policies and Procedures shall prevail; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the aforesaid Personnel Policies and Procedures Manual are intended to provide guidelines governing public service by Township employees and is not a Contract. The provisions of this Manual may be amended and supplemented from time to time without notice and at the sole discretion of the Township Committee; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, to the maximum extent permitted by law, employment practices for the Township shall operate under the legal doctrine known as "Employment at Will"; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all managerial/supervisory personnel are responsible for these employment practices. The Township Administrator shall supervise and manage such personnel in the implementation of the Policies and Procedures in this Manual.
