

### STRENGTHS BINGO

#### SETTING UP STRENGTHS BINGO

- 1. Print out the Caller's Cards and cut out each of the 24 strengths. Fold up the slips of paper and put them in a hat/bowl/bag/box to randomly pull out, unfold, and read. If you want, you can also print a second copy of the Caller's Cards to keep track of which strengths have been called.
- 2. Print out a set of Strengths Bingo cards, cut them out, and distribute them to a small group. There are 12 unique cards included in this kit. Or, print out a single large Strengths Bingo card to play cooperatively! (There are 3 unique Cooperative Strengths Bingo cards.)
- 3. Collect a number of items to use as markers while playing, such as coins, candies, or buttons. If you're not planning on re-using the Strengths Bingo cards, you can also just mark off squares directly on the cards with a pen, pencil, or marker.

#### PLAYING STRENGTHS BINGO

- 1. Pull out a random strength, and whomever raises their hand can give an honest example of how they used that strength recently.
- 2. Once someone has shared their example, everyone can mark that strength down on their card. (If no one is able to give an answer, you can set that strength aside or return it to the pile and pull out a new strength.)
- 3. Continue pulling out and sharing stories about using each strength until someone is able to mark a row, column, or diagonal of 5 strengths on their card.

**Variation #1:** Player take turns pulling strengths. Whoever pulls out the strength should try to share their story. Only the person who shares can mark their card.

**Variation #2:** Instead of sharing examples of how you've used a specific strength recently, you can choose a different theme for your game. For instance, describing a historic or fictional character who exemplefies the strength, or describing how someone could practice the strength in everyday life.

### COOPERATIVE STRENGTHS BINGO

In Cooperative Strengths Bingo, a group shares a single card. You can hang the card up where everyone can see and mark each strength with sticky notes written by whoever shares their story.

This is a great way to encourage practicing and recognizing strengths over time, as a group (family, classroom) can continue to add on to the same game card over a day, week, month, or however long you want to keep playing!

### STRENGTHS BINGO CALLER'S CARD PAGE #2

### KINDNESS

[Generosity, nurturance, care, compassion, altruistic love, "niceness"]: Doing favors and good deeds for others. You like helping people and taking care of them.

#### LOVE

Valuing close relations with others, especially when your feelings are returned. You're good at being close to people.

### PERSEVERANCE

[Persistence, industriousness]: Finishing what you start, even if there are obstacles. You get things done, and it makes you feel good.

### PRUDENCE

Being careful about your choices. not taking unnecessary risks. You don't say or do things that you'll regret.

### SOCIAL INTELLIGENCE

[Emotional intelligence, personal intelligence]: Being aware of the motives and feelings of other people, and yourself. You know how to fit into different social situations.

### TEAMWORK

[Citizenship, social responsibility, loyalty]: Working well as a member of a group or team. You're loyal to the group and you always do your fair share.

### LEADERSHIP

Encouraging a group you're a part of to get things done. You try to keep good relationships with everyone in the group. You're good at organizing efforts and seeing them through.

### LOVE OF LEARNING

Getting as much information as you can about topics you love. This can also involve mastering as many skills as you can. You keep adding, and adding, and adding to what you know.

### PERSPECTIVE

[Wisdom]: Giving good advice to others. You have ways of looking at the world that make sense to yourself and to other people. You understand the big picture.

### SELF-REGULATION

[Self-control]: Controlling what you feel and do. You have great discipline and control over your appetite and emotions.

### SPIRITUALITY

[Faith, purpose]: Having beliefs about the higher purpose and meaning of life. You know where you fit in the world, and you have beliefs that shape what you do.

### ZEST

[Vitality, enthusiasm, vigor, energy]: Approaching life with excitement and energy. Nothing is half hearted for you. Life is an adventure, and it makes you feel alive.

### ALL ABOUT STRENGTHS

The VIA classification of strengths came from a multiyear project in which 55 top social scientists asked the following question: What is best about humans? Over three years, these scientists researched the world's major writings on religion, philosophy, organizational studies, youth development, psychiatry, and psychology, among others, to seek out the virtues and strengths valued across cultures and time. The goal was for this group to leave no stone unturned in order to produce an exhaustive list of character strengths. In order to avoid redundancies and narrow the list, the group made sure each strength followed certain criteria:

Each character strength...

- is ubiquitous or widely recognized across cultures
- is fulfilling or contributes to individual fulfillment, satisfaction, and happiness
- is morally valued or valued on its own and not for any outcome it may produce
- does not diminish others or elevates others who see it in action
- has an opposite or has obvious antonyms that are negative
- is trait-like or exhibits patterns that are generally stable over time
- is measurable or has been successfully measured by researchers
- is distinct or is not redundant with other strengths
- has paragons or individuals who are exemplars of the strength
- has prodigies or is shown precociously in some youth
- can be selectively absent or missing in some individuals altogether
- has enabling institutions or is a deliberate goal of society

The result of all of this work is the VIA classification, or the list of 6 core virtues and the 24 character strengths categorized within them.
