This confidence engenders community support for the law enforcement agency. Improving the relationship between the officers and the citizens they serve facilitates cooperation vital to the department's ability to achieve its goals. Internal Affairs will also ensure fairness and due process protection to citizens and officers alike. The internal affairs process shall also be used to identify and correct unclear or inappropriate agency procedures. It is the policy of the Montgomery Police Department to accept and investigate all complaints of alleged officer misconduct or wrongdoing from any citizen or employee of the department including anonymous sources.
